Dear Parents/Guardians of Charter, Parochial, and Non-public school students,

The admissions testing process for any current 8th and 9th graders interested in attending Dr. Ronald E. McNair Academic High School and Infinity Institute has commenced. Students enrolled in district schools will now test at their home school during the school day. **As a result, Dr. Ronald E. McNair Academic and Infinity Institute will not be administering a Saturday admissions test.** Thus, any 8th or 9th grade students in Jersey City who are interested in applying to one or both schools must participate in the district's National PSAT/SAT Day. This will be their only opportunity to test for admission.

Any 8th or 9th grade student who is not enrolled in the Jersey City Public Schools, but would like to apply to one or both of the aforementioned schools will be given the opportunity to take the PSAT 8/9 Assessment on the morning of **Wednesday, October 11, 2017** at:

On the day of testing, students will be required to report at 7:45 a.m. and bring their testing ticket and student ID.

School counselors will receive 2018-2019 applications for both schools by **November 1, 2017**. As in the past, your child's school counselor will work with your child's teachers to complete their admissions application. School counselors will submit your child's PSAT 8/9 score results with their completed application to each school as required. All completed applications are due your child's school counselor by **December 1, 2017**.
