Give your child the computer skills they need so they can focus on the project rather than the mechanics. The first objective of this class is to help improve your child's typing skills. They will use Microsoft Word to write their own memoir, autobiography or short story. Your child will then learn the basics of Microsoft Excel including formatting, graph and chart creation, and writing simple formulas.
